



Disciples multiply at Bellevue

Have you ever wondered whether or not God's hand is at work in your life? Typically one of the ways I know that God is in my life, my decisions, or my next ministry directive is that an idea comes to me that I would never have the until of on my own. In other words

have thought of on my own. In other words God (through His Word, the Holy Spirit, or other believers) plants an idea in my mind that so blows me away that I simply say, "God must be in this, so I'd better do it!" This is exactly what happened while talking with Steve Fine in the front seat of my Honda outside his hotel.

Steve had come to our church to host a singles' conference and consult with me on how to do ministry. Unimpressed with the programming and events we were wrapped up in, he simply said, "You must begin discipling your people." Though I'd heard this before, the Lord used Steve and his challenge to propel me into a wonderful journey I have led our ministry in over the past eighteen months.

We chose the *One on One with God* curriculum and began with a guys' group and a ladies' group, both with six disciple-maker hopefuls. We have recently launched our third round of discipleship groups and have touched

nearly one hundred participants! Included in this number are twenty-one single men and women who discipled others using *One on One*.

One on One with God was the right choice for us for two reasons. First, it is an avenue that addresses the main need single adults have: staying focused on Christ. One on One shows how to better know Christ through daily Bible reading, meditation, and prayer. Second, it is also an avenue that addresses the main focus that single adults should have: the Great Commission! Making disciples is outwardly focused, which is perfect for singles who naturally gravitate toward focusing on themselves.

The feedback from what God has done through *One on One* has been amazing.

Adults for the first time are learning how to know Him through their devotional lives. They love the accountability of meeting together in a group, and they are stretched by the challenge to lead a group themselves.

We knew early on that God was in our beginning a discipleship ministry using *One on One*, and He has definitely blessed us through it.

Discipleship in Central Africa

In March 2007 I participated in a short-term mission trip to Rwanda. God used a few North Americans and His people in Rwanda to plant ten churches and lead over 3700 people to faith in Christ. I was amazed and excited but was troubled over how to disciple these new converts.

Through *One on One with* God I became a disciplemaker, and while I was in Rwanda, God made it possible for me to begin leading my interpreter, John, through One on One. John

was a pastor and had learned to preach and lead in the church, but he had never learned to enjoy genuine, consistent intimacy with Christ or to make disciples.

What we began in Rwanda, John and I completed through a series of phone calls after I returned home. As John worked through One on One, he shared with other pastors what God was teaching him and asked for more copies so that he could disciple his friends. When I returned to Rwanda in September 2007, John had discipled several people, and several of these were discipling others using One on One with God. John was seeing a demand for discipleship everywhere he went. One on One was changing lives as people learned to walk with Christ in intimate fellowship, and he had a big vision for the people of Central Africa.

Yet John had a problem: Most people in Rwanda do not speak English, so he would have to translate One on One into the Kinyarwanda language. In October 2007 John and his translation team began work, and in just a few months, they generated a rough draft and are working diligently to complete the task.

John has caught the vision and wants to be used by God to spark a discipleship movement in Rwanda, Tanzania, Burundi, western Uganda, Kenya, and the eastern Congo, where over 40 million people speak his language. He believes One on One with God is a powerfully effective tool for raising up disciples who make disciples, and he envisions a day when Rwanda becomes a nation sending disciple-makers throughout the world.

My vision for reaching people who speak Kinyarwanda

I understand the importance of One on One with God reaching the hands of the maximum number of people—in essence, to reach all the Kinyarwanda-speaking communities wherever they are. There are millions in Rwanda, Tanzania, Burundi, western Uganda, Kenya, and eastern Congo. Though this may and will take a more thorough vision-casting than I can now conceive, I can give a general picture:

Assuming sufficient funds are available, ten more welldiscipled people would be involved in this movement and dispatched to five regions of our country, two to each province. Because One on One with God has a built-in approach to make disciples who are at the same time disciple-makers,

the discipled people will remain to disciple their neighborhoods while the two original disciple-makers are taking Christ to new realms of churches planted by e3 Ministry and then to others.

In addition, we would disciple different denominations within Kigali (these denominations have daughter churches around the country) and encourage them to pass on One on One with God to their church members. Finally, I would ensure more systematic follow-up of this discipleship movement.

May God stand with you in your tireless efforts to make Christ known to the whole world.

'A compelling and strong need' for One on One with God discipleship Disciple-maker/church planter, Rwanda

Many believers in the churches around this region have been preached to; yes, they have heard the message preached and submissively professed faith in the Son of God. However, they know not how to maintain relationship with Him. In other words, they haven't been discipled.

Before One on One with God was introduced to me, I didn't know any other consistent and coherent means by which one can be made a disciple of Christ. One on One with God

is a tool that imparts knowledge of the way to all those who passionately follow it.


There's actually a compelling and strong need for discipleship of this

kind, especially among the populations of Rwanda, Tanzania, Kenya, Burundi, eastern Congo, and western Uganda (Bufumbira). These regions will not only be easily accessible for discipleship but will also be able to use One on One with God in the same language—Kinyarwanda.

All the people to whom I introduced One on One with God yearn to see it used in their churches in their language. Jimmy is a Rwandan pastor at Jesus Church in Kigali, and his passion to disciple his church has been limited only by

having to rely on One on One with God in English.

Iam privileged to be in contact with many pastors

in my country. And more than that,

through e3 Partners Ministry I have been able to introduce One on One with God to many e3 Ministry partners, not only those in Rwanda but those in Burundi who join us in the campaigns. This blessing has opened doors to Burundi.

The e3 Partners Ministry is a blessing to Rwanda in seeing its church-planting vision and strategies laid out to fulfill it. This vision, once it is coupled with strategies to nurture (disciple) these spiritual babes, will build a solid, lasting church in our country. The potential results are immense.

Discipleship movement gains momentum in Orange County Jail By Jim Parker, Disciple-maker

Over the past few months I have been teaching a weekly message of encouragement and exhortation in the "Christian block" of the Orange County Jail in Orlando, Florida.

Many times I find myself teaching from the lessons found in One on One with God because the men respond so positively and strongly to these life-changing truths. They particularly appreciate the simple, powerful teaching on how to regularly receive a word from God.

As I teach, I often focus the men's attention on the opportunity each of us

has for a personal, intimate relationship with Jesus and on the joy and life-transforming power we can experience as we pursue that relationship. Many have always seen Christianity as a bunch of do and don't rules they cannot keep,

causing them to walk in guilt and separation from God. The concept of a genuinely intimate love relationship with Christ has somehow eluded them.

Recently several men strongly encouraged me to lead them through One on One with God. I agreed with a condition: The men I discipled must then disciple their peers.

Eight weeks ago, I began discipling a group of five men, and they have expressed how great a difference

One on One is making in their lives. They have even begun reproducing their faith as they disciple other inmates using One on One with God. A discipleship movement is gaining momentum in the Orange County Jail!

Because we desire to be true disciples of Jesus Christ, it is a natural outflow to make disciples for His kingdom. When we see lives being changed by daily growth in the Word, our joy is immeasurable, and we grow as well! We've seen the power of God change people, causing their children and spouses to seek discipleship training. pastor and other ministers in our fellowship became involved. At least three hundred individuals have gone through One on One with God to date, and new people are continually asking to be discipled. Our pastor, Dr. Rod Masteller, speaks about One on One with God from the pulpit and has said, "God has absolutely transformed over one hundred lives at Summer Grove

Baptist Church through *One on One with God*. The intimacy with Christ that individuals, including my wife, have found has been remarkable. What I have found as the most visible trait of those who have been discipled through *One on One with God* is an outward reflection of an inward peace that every human being on this earth is desperately seeking."

As business owners we totally embrace disciple-making as our ministry unto the Lord. Many of our employees have asked to be discipled—even when they are members of other denominations. Bolivian leaders want One on One

We had a great event in Bolivia this spring. Forty-six pastors and leaders attended

over two days, responding very enthusiastically and wanting to know how to get more *One* on *One* materials. Several asked how to get *One* on *One* with *God* produced for Bolivia, seeing the potential for a great impact. Several of the leaders brought their Timothys to the meeting, and both left with a renewed vision for producing disciple-makers. I placed all of the books into the hands of pastors who either had their groups at the training or had a very small group

Before I departed for Bolivia, I received an e-mail from a friend telling me that her brother Scott would be on the trip to Bolivia. She asked me to try and introduce *One*

on One to him. As it turned out, Scott ended up doing the bulk of my translation. We have discussed finishing One on One when we return to Orlando. He happens to live only a couple of blocks from my home, but God had to send us to

Bolivia to get us together. He is looking forward to completing the material and becoming a disciple-maker.

The national leader for e3 Partners in Bolivia did not attend, but he received so much positive feedback that he wanted to discuss setting up a weekend retreat to provide intensive discipleship training to pastors and their Timothys. His heart is aligned with ours for helping the church become a disciple-making church. I also introduced *One on One* to his grateful administrative assistant, a woman who has been searching for a tool to disciple some of her friends.

If I could have scripted the training, the enthusiasm, and the potential for the beginning of a disciple-making move-

ment, I cannot imagine how I could improve upon what happened. God showed up, and I have



confidence He will build His church. I feel very privileged to be able to light a match in Bolivia using the product of your obedience to God. I thank God for the way He continues to change me through the power of His Word and for allowing me to witness as He makes great changes in the lives of others through this powerful tool.

Coming soon to a home near you: One on One with God for families

Impress them [God's commandments] on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

—Deuteronomy 6:7 NIV

Probably everyone would agree that parents of growing children are busy people with demanding lives. Christian parents, however, face the additional task of teaching

their children to be true disciples of Jesus Christ. Thankfully, Shawn and Amber Crawley are preparing a tool to help moms and dads disciple their children in a way that meshes well with 21st-century family life.

The Crawleys, of Shawnee, Oklahoma, recently began work on an adaptation of *One on One with God*, aimed at equipping parents to teach personal spiritual disciplines to their children and incorporate intentional family times throughout the week to facilitate additional development of spiritual disciplines as a family lifestyle.

To avoid creating additional busy-ness in family schedules, the Crawleys are formatting *One on One* based on four instances of family life that are likely already in place in the lifestyles of many families. Using concepts from Deuterono-

my 6:7, the spiritual disciplines are incorporated as follows:

- "When you get up"—helps a child develop an individual quiet time in the morning.
- "When you walk along the road"—uses transition times (going to/from school, work, store, etc.) to talk about certain content areas and to incorporate intentional Scripture memory review.
- "When you sit at home"—establishes or reinforces intentional family devotional times, one to three times per week, where family members examine study content together.
- "When you lie down"—establishes or reinforces intentional family prayer time.

It is the Crawleys' desire—and ours as well—that this tool would encourage and equip parents to live out Psalm 78:4—"We will not hide them from [our] children; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the LORD, His power, and the wonders He has done."

Shawn and Amber Crawley have been married for 13 years and have four sons. Shawn earned a master's degree in marriage and family therapy from Oklahoma Baptist University and has completed two years of study at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. Amber holds a degree in church music from OBU and devotes much of her time to homeschooling their sons and teaching private music lessons.

Mark McClellan to serve as GFTF Field Representative for Mexico

We are excited to announce that Dr. Mark McClellan has agreed to represent Go Face to Face International, Inc. He will serve GFTF as our Field Representative for Mexico in addition to his current position as Professor of Christian Theology and Missions at Boyce College, a school of The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary.

Mark was responsible for the translation of One on One with God into Spanish and Quiché Indian. Mark was a very successful lawyer when God called him to serve in missions. After earning a master's degree from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, he attended language school and in his first four-year term

was responsible for the translation of *One on One with God* into Spanish and Quiché Indian. Over the next three years, Mark served as a church planter for the International Mission Board in Guatemala. The Spanish and Quiché translations of *One on One* became the tools he and his wife Cindy used to plant churches among both Mayan and Latin peoples.

Mark and Cindy later returned to Southwestern Seminary where he earned his Ph.D. He has served as a pastor, minister of evangelism, associate pastor of an inner city mission, pastor of Spanish-speaking new church plants, and state

One one One encourages our soldiers in Afghanistan, Iraq, and Qatar Captain, USAF

During my deployment to the Middle East, I had the privilege of sharing *One on One with God* with service men and women serving in Iraq, Afghanistan, Qatar, and other nations in the region. Extended trips from home—and deploy-

'I had to make the most of whatever time we had, trusting God to work out the details.' ments in particular—have a way of opening someone's heart to God in ways that few things can. Deployed service members deal with a barrage

of events and experiences, including risk of death or injury from terrorist activities, regular mortar and rocket attacks, and enemy threats while conducting offensive and security operations. Many also face marriage problems, separation issues, and a host of other family and social issues. Thanks to the nearly instantaneous nature of communications today, many find themselves engaged in the struggles of life back home while fighting on the front lines. Although the military provides for our soldiers the food, facilities, recreation, and support they need, these men and women still face a void in their lives that for some leads to loneliness and helplessness in the midst of their circumstances. It is at this point of brokenness that people will open their hearts to Jesus.

Change is a constant for those who are deployed, and no one is certain how long a deployment will last, when he might be deployed forward, or if the mission will change. When I began leading *One on One* for the first time, I was determined to teach a standard fifteen-week course spanning the deployment rotation. That plan was short-lived, however, and I had to make the most of whatever time we had, trusting God to work out the details. I learned to appreciate *One on One* as a path, a lifestyle, and a guide. No matter how much time I had with someone or where he was in his walk, the book was a tremendous leg-up on his journey.

During my deployment, I had the privilege of sharing with many. One man was led to Christ, one lady started her journey through *One* on *One* before returning to Iraq for an extended tour, and another man started using *One* on *One* to disciple the people in his unit who were not able to attend the meetings because of the odd schedules associated with flying operations over Afghanistan. Yet another man, who served in the National Guard, took *One* on *One* back to his home church.

When I was a seventeen-year-old new believer, I could never have imagined myself discipling people while supporting combat operations in the Middle East. Nearly four years after first going through *One on One with God*, I continue to use my copy and refer to its lessons often. Despite the chaos and uncertainty around me, I have always had a peace in knowing God is in control. *One on One* has helped make that a reality for those on the front lines, and they will, in turn, share with others in this vast mission field. God willing, these people and those they touch can be part of spiritual multiplication in places that only they can reach today, sowing seeds for the Kingdom by loving the Lord above all else and loving their neighbors as themselves.






